



OVYSL Board Meeting Minutes 2014 June Meeting

II. Review of May 2014 Meeting Minutes

The prior month's meeting minutes were reviewed. A grammatical error was raised. Motion to accept made by Chris Monahan with a second by Greg Smart. All approved.

III. League Administration

A. D2 Update

1. The District is continuing efforts to purchase additional property for expanded field space. The property currently identified is in the county. The City is planning to purchase the property, with the intent to re-zone it. An initial offer was made and a counter offer was received. Discussions and negotiations continue with all interested parties involved in securing the new space.

2. CCSL registration is currently in progress.

3. A discussion regarding the distinction between NorCal and CCSL took place. While OCYSL is predominantly a CCSL club based on registrations, OVYSL represents both to represent all of our player's interest.

B. Water Update

Water is currently running at the MHOSC. We're working on having the current process automated. MHYSA is supporting the new system and providing feedback to OVYSL.

C. Uniform Update

- With Eurosport, our current provider, uniforms will be available for order through September.

- With our new provider, Asby's, uniforms can be purchased online or in store. Numbers will be on the back of the jersey and on the shorts, last names will not be on the jersey. Many teams will leverage their current uniforms through the Fall and can place orders for new uniforms for the Spring 2015 season.

D. Banners

Registration announcement banners have been posted locally. One has been placed on Peebles and Monterey Rd. The other one has been placed at Watsonville and Monterey Rd. There are three additional banners available for placement. Suggestions were made to post additional banners at Butterfield/Dunne, the MH Aquatics Center and by the CRC/Dog Park area.

E. Sports Authority

Sports Authority (Gilroy) would like to offer a fundraising opportunity on June 28th to OVYSL players and team, as part of the store's grand re-opening. Teams can sell hot dogs and refreshments in front of the store. The store has agreed



to place OVYSL flyers in all customer bags for the next few weeks.

IV. Participant Administration

A. Summer camp status

One camp was held, facilitated by Coever. No additional camps have been scheduled.

B. Fall Registration

Recreation registration is currently open and late fee's will be applied starting July 1. Competitive registration will open immediately following the recreational registration period.
